What is Biodiesel?

Biodiesel is the name of a clean burning alternative fuel, produced from domestic, renewable resources. Biodiesel contains no petroleum, but it can be blended at any level with petroleum diesel to create a biodiesel blend. It can be used in diesel engines with little or no modifications. Biodiesel is simple to use, biodegradable, nontoxic, and essentially free of sulfur and aromatics. Biodiesel can be used as a pure fuel or blended with petroleum in any percentage.

Biodiesel is registered as a fuel and fuel additive with the Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) and meets clean diesel standards established by the California Air Resources Board (CARB). Neat (100 percent) biodiesel has been designated as an alternative fuel by the Department of Energy (DOE) and the US Department of Transportation (DOT).

Biodiesel is the first and only alternative fuel to have a complete evaluation of emission results and potential health effects submitted to the EPA. Biodiesel reduces regulated emissions by between 45 and 67%, and non-regulated emissions such as sulfur by up to 100%.



A Unique Philosophy

Biodiesel can be produced from a number of food sources, but Amereco and Green Dining are committed to producing biodiesel only by recycling waste vegetable oil that would otherwise be disposed of in our landfills or used for other non-productive purposes. Our alliance and dedication to this process minimizes the impact on our landfills and does not take away from our food supply.

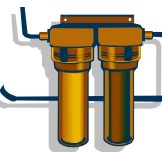
Our Process

How do Amereco and Green Dining work together to produce biodiesel? The process works as follows:



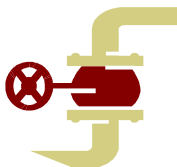
Restaurants use vegetable oil in their cooking process, thus creating impure waste oil.

Green Dining travels to each of its member restaurants and collects their waste oil.



Green Dining brings the oil to its Glendale Operations Center for filtering and cleaning.

Green Dining delivers this filtered and cleaned oil to Amereco for processing.



Amereco converts the waste oil into biodiesel using a process called transesterification.

Amereco delivers the completed biodiesel to its fuel distribution partners.



The finished biodiesel is then sold to fleets, individuals and other users. Reduced emissions, cleaner air!

Biodiesel Benefits

- Refined from recycled fats and oils.
- Delivers similar or *better* engine performance than conventional diesel.
- Improved lubricity than conventional diesel.
- Non-hazardous, with a flash point of 300°F vs. 125°F for #2 petroleum diesel.
- Much cleaner burning than conventional diesel.
- As biodegradable as sugar.
- Less toxic than table salt.
- Helps with clean air, clean water and clean soil.
- Creates a domestic petroleum product that keeps our energy dollars at home instead of sending them to foreign countries.
- No need for special fueling equipment.
- No need for special safety equipment.
- Virtual elimination of the generation of carcinogenic Polycyclic Aromatic Hydrocarbons (PAH) compared to conventional diesel.
