To Whom It May Concern:

A Greener Day Recycling was born from our interest in and commitment to renewable and sustainable energy. We partner with businesses in the restaurant and hospitality industry to collect and recycle their used cooking oil (UCO). We also partner with select companies who have a similar mission by purchasing their cooking oil and processing it on their behalf for resale.

Processing the UCO involves filtering, cleaning, and dewatering. This removes impurities in the oil and makes it suitable for resale. Once processed, we sell the UCO to various clients. Most notably, we provide UCO to the Grand Canyon Railway where it is used as fuel to run their Steam Engine #4960. This replaces the use of standard diesel fuel in that engine. The UCO also goes to companies for the production of biodiesel as the market dictates. We sell oil to various manufacturers for that purpose. They, in turn, distribute it locally and nationally through their own distribution networks. Some of the UCO is also used locally as a supplement in cattle feed.

One of our long-term valued partners is Green Oil, LLC (dba Green Dining Network), based in Phoenix. Green Dining Network sells us their UCO for processing and sale as described above. We have chosen to work with Green Dining Network because of their similar environmental focus, and their commitment to the highest levels of customer service and business ethics. Green Dining currently works with hospitality businesses in the greater Phoenix and Tucson regions.
